MEDICAL, DENTAL AND VISION

**Supplemental Medical, Vision and Dental:
100 percent paid by USLI**

▶ **Medical**

- Prescription drugs
- Extended health care
- Emergency travel assistance

▶ **Vision**

- Exam every 24 months-adults
- Exam every 12 months child(ren)

▶ **Dental**

- Basic services
- Major restorative
- Preventive services

▶ **Life and Disability**

- Accidental death, disease and dismemberment \$50,000
- Dependent spouse life \$10,000
- Dependent child life \$5,000

▶ **Individual Disability Insurance**

- Individually underwritten
- Starts on 91st day of disability
- Pays 60 percent of your monthly salary




FINANCIAL AND RETIREMENT

- ▶ Profit sharing plan with up to 15 percent of annual compensation; vested over five years at 20 percent per year
- ▶ Discretionary performance bonus



FAMILY AND LIFESTYLE

- ▶ Adoption assistance at \$7,500 per year for qualified expenses
- ▶ Employee Assistance Program, through Health Advocate to assist with work life balance
- ▶ Access to Health Advocate services to assist with your healthcare needs
- ▶ Opportunity to request donations to charities or causes to which employees have personal connection through USLI's 501(c)3 CARE² Fund



DEVELOPMENT

- ▶ More than 450 free personal and professional development courses on-site annually
- ▶ Tuition reimbursement up to \$1,500 per year
- ▶ Approved self-study programs paid at 100 percent, each with monetary incentive



VACATION AND TIME OFF

- ▶ Up to 10 paid holidays per year
